

Latin Vocabulary changes for new curriculum

The ISEB Classics syllabus has recently been updated (for first examination from Autumn 2014), and can be read here:

Galore Park's [Latin Vocabulary for Key Stage 3 and Common Entrance](#) (fourth edition) is still appropriate for pupils preparing for the 13+ Latin Common Entrance **Level 2** and **Level 3** exams from Autumn 2014. However there has been an addition of two verbs and one noun, which are listed below.

dēbeō, -ēre, -uī, -itum	I ought, owe
inquit/inquiunt	he/they say(s) (quoting direct speech)
līberī, -ōrum, m. pl.	offspring, sons and daughters, children (i.e. in relation to their parents)

NB these three additional words are not required for pupils taking the Latin Level 1 exam.
